### **Interview questions student Master Social and Cultural Anthropology VU**

1. What do you consider to be important aspects of 'diversity competences' of an anthropologist, dealing with diversity issues and working in a context that is characterized by diversity?
2. To what extent (mark from 1 to 10) do you think you master these competences?
3. How did the Master contribute to your development in these diversity competences? (Strengths). Subquestions:
  - What (elements of) courses contributed?
  - Which learning activities (individual and group), literature, assignments, exams contributed?
  - What (elements of) the learning environment contributed? (How) did cooperation with peers contributed? How did teaching styles and quality of teaching?
4. What did you miss in the Master program regarding diversity competencies? What should be improved? (Weaknesses and recommendations)

### ***Background: Project Diversity sensitive Education at VU University.***

The project aims to improve educational programs regarding the way they pay attention to diversity and prepare students to deal with issues related to diversity. Therefore, different educational programs at VU University are investigated, by analysing the content of the courses of the curriculum, interviewing teachers and interviewing students.
